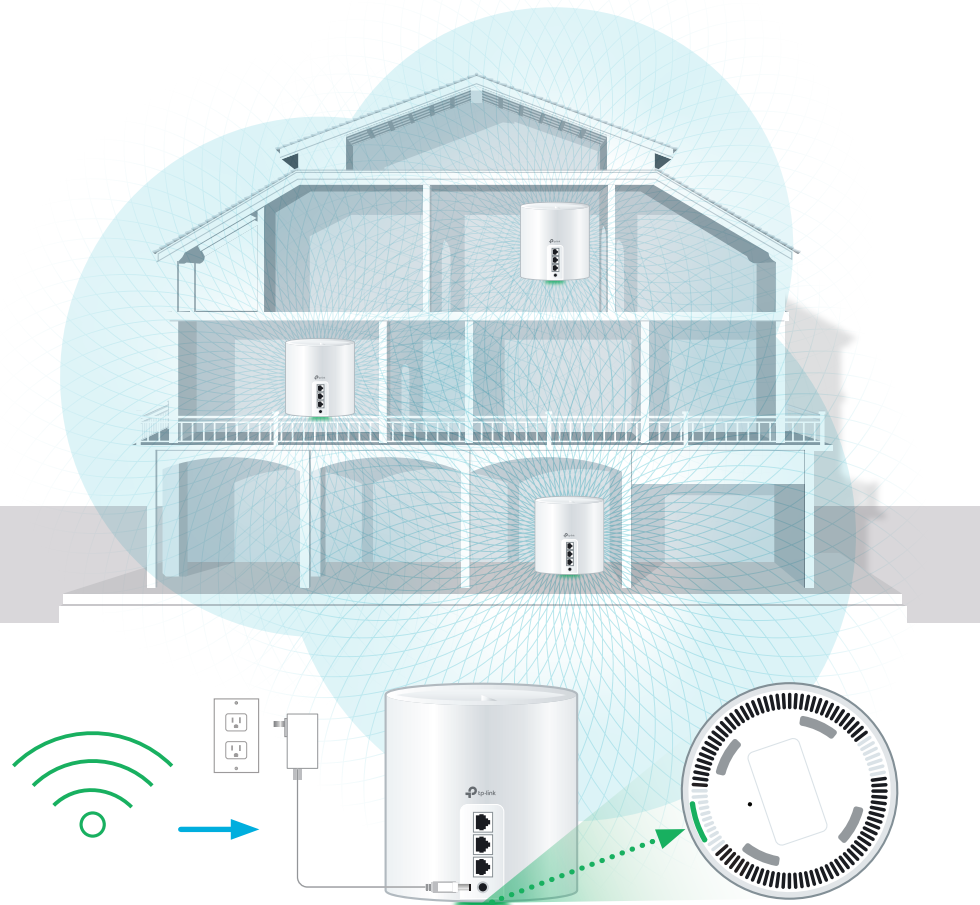


Boost your Wi-Fi signal and coverage with additional pods.

Follow these easy steps to add more pods and create the strongest Wi-Fi experience in every room.



- Place the pod in the desired location within range of your Wi-Fi signal and connect the pod to a power outlet.
- When the light on the pod is solid green, your Wi-Fi is now active. If the light is red, position the additional pod closer to an active pod until the light is green.
- **Tip:** Use your smartphone to test the Wi-Fi strength in the location for a pod.

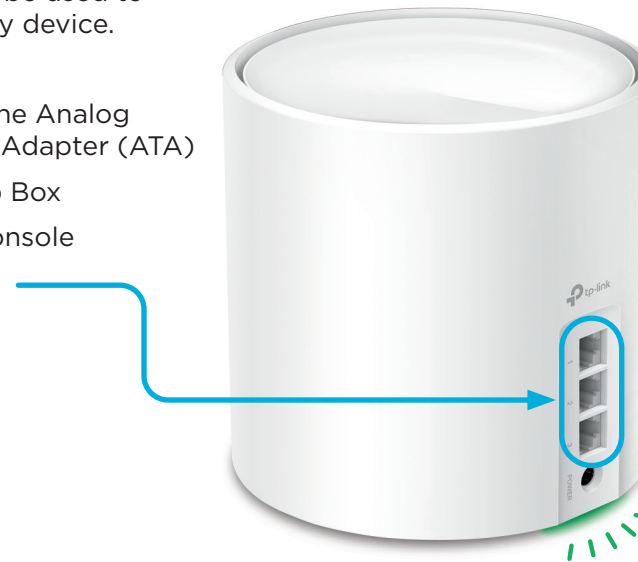
Connecting Wired Devices

Each Wi-Fi 6 Pod is equipped with three ethernet ports

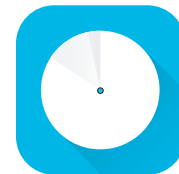
These ports can be used to connect a nearby device.

For example:

- Home Phone Analog Telephone Adapter (ATA)
- TV Set Top Box
- Gaming Console
- Computer



Download the TP-Link Deco app from the Google Play or Apple App Store.



Use the app to customize your Wi-Fi Network (SSID) name and password.

You will also find other features such as: parental controls, anti-virus and how to create a separate network for guests.

Setting Up Your Fibre Internet Service and Wi-Fi Network

The Technician will setup your Wi-Fi if you have a scheduled installation.

Use this guide only if you do not have a scheduled installation and already have an active Nokia ONT at your home.

To Self Install Your Wi-Fi:

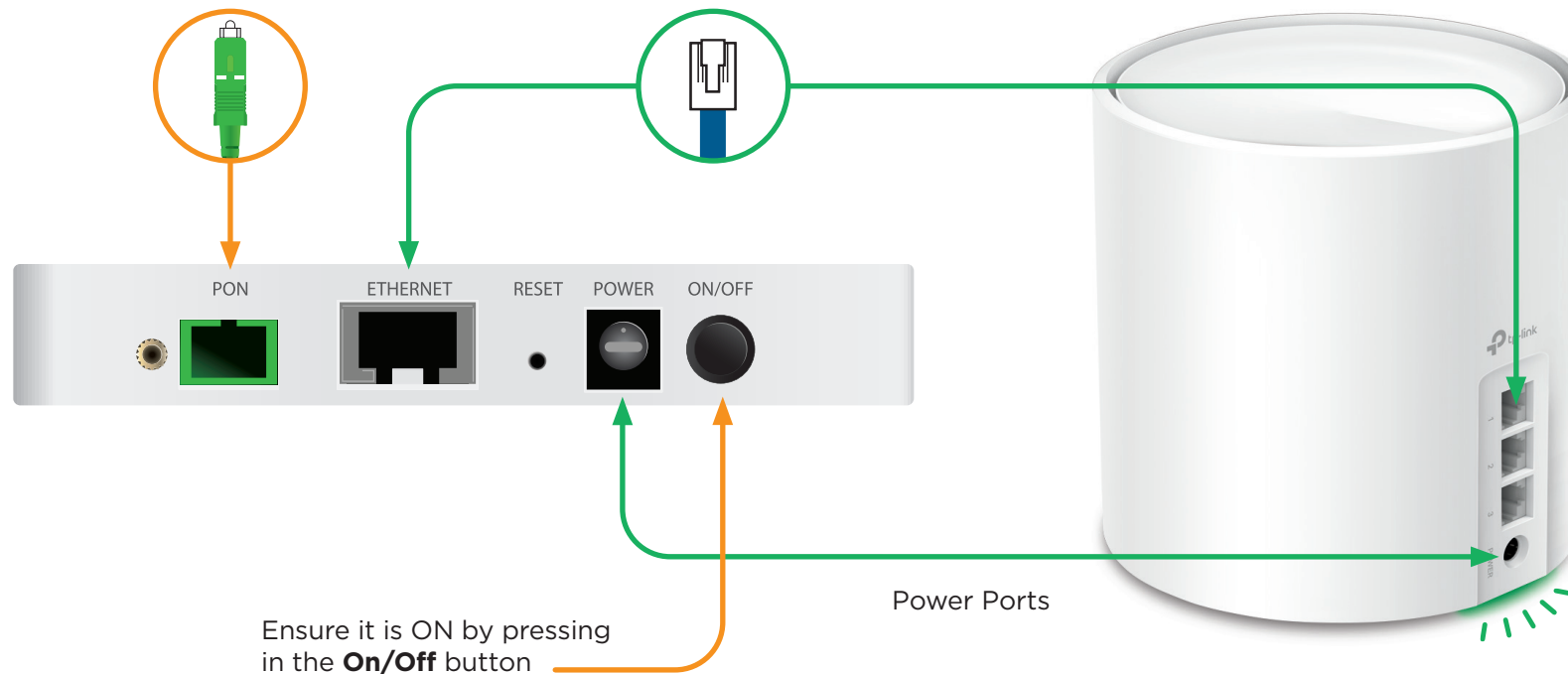
Your ONT should already be installed and connected to the Fibre Internet Connector cable. If it is not, follow steps 1 and 2.

Review the contents of your install Kit:

- Deco X50 Wi-Fi 6 Pod and power cord
- Ethernet cable for your Wi-Fi 6 pod
- Ensure you follow the steps in order shown

1 Ensure the ONT is plugged in, **Powered ON** and a **Fibre Internet cable is connected**.

Warning: Adjustments to the Fibre box may result in electrical hazard and Internet Service Disruption.



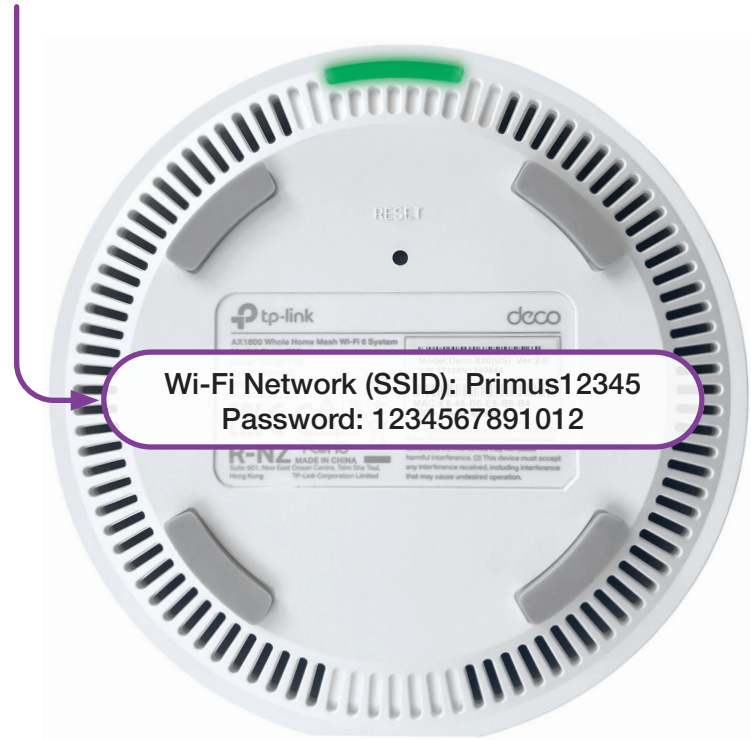
2 Connect the **ETHERNET** cable from the ONT to the POD. Connect your Wi-Fi 6 pod to a **Power Outlet**.

The Wi-Fi 6 pod light will turn solid green. This can take about 5 minutes.

Tip: If the light is Red, restart the ONT and pod by unplugging the power adaptors.

Wait 30 seconds, plug in the ONT.
Wait 30 seconds, plug in the pod.

3 Go to Wi-Fi settings on a device you would like to connect, and search for available Wi-Fi networks. Select the **Wi-Fi Network (SSID)** and enter the password that matches those found on the bottom of your Wi-Fi 6 pod.



That's it, you should now be ready to enjoy your Primus Wi-Fi!
